

Department of Workforce Services Child-Care Subsidy Summary

The Utah Department of Workforce Services offers a subsidy to help pay for <u>childcare</u> costs. <u>Eligibility Criteria:</u>

- Eligible children must be under the age of 13 and/or a special-needs child under the age of 18.
- Children must be U.S. citizens or qualified aliens. Parents do not need to provide any information regarding immigration status, work authorization, or social security numbers.
- Single parents must work an average of at least 15 hours per week and make at least minimum wage. For 2-parent households, the second parent must work an average of at least 30 hours a week.
- Must use a <u>licensed childcare provider</u>, or Family/Friend/Neighbor or license-exempt provider that is <u>approved by DWS</u>.
- Must meet the following <u>Income Limits</u> (85% of the State Median Income):

Household Size	Monthly Income Limit	Annual Income Limit
2	\$4,511	\$54,132
3	\$5,574	\$66,888
4	\$6,635	\$79,620
5	\$7,697	\$92,364

• The amount of potential <u>payments</u> (paid directly to providers) depends upon the age of the child and the type of provider. For example, maximum monthly child-care payments to center-based, licensed providers for full-time care are as follows:

0-24 Months	2 Years	3 Years	4 years Old	5 Years Old	6-<13 Years
