

Department of Workforce Services Child-Care Subsidy

The Utah Department of Workforce Services offers a subsidy to help pay for [childcare](#) costs.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Eligible children must be under the age of 13 and/or a special-needs child under the age of 18.
- Children must be U.S. citizens or qualified aliens. Parents do not need to provide any information regarding immigration status, work authorization, or social security numbers.
- Single parents must work an average of at least 15 hours per week and make at least minimum wage. For 2-parent households, the second parent must work an average of at least 30 hours a week.
- Must use a [licensed childcare provider](#), or Family/Friend/Neighbor or license-exempt provider that is [approved by DWS](#).
- Must meet the following [Income Limits](#) (85% of the State Median Income):

Household Size	Monthly Income Limit	Annual Income Limit
2	\$4,127	\$49,524
3	\$5,098	\$61,176
4	\$6,069	\$72,828
5	\$7,041	\$84,492
6	\$8,012	\$96,144
7	\$8,194	\$98,328

- The amount of potential [payments](#) (paid directly to providers) depends upon the age of the child and the type of provider. For example, maximum monthly child-care payments to center-based, licensed providers for full-time care are as follows:

0-24 Months	2 Years	3 Years	4 years Old	5 Years Old	6-<13 Years Old
\$1043	\$821	\$757	\$754	\$731	\$621
